Applications are being sought for entry into St. John's C. of E Nursery and Reception classes for September 2019.

Children must be 3 years of age by September 2019 to be eligible for Nursery, and, 4 years of age by September 2019 for Reception.

Please call into the school for a Supplementary Information Form (SIF) if your child is eligible.

The SIF forms for Nursery must be completed and returned to the Infant site by 11th January 2019.

If you are applying for a Reception place you must complete the online application at www.oldham.gov.uk/admissions by 15th January 2019. St. John's admission criteria is available on the school website.
