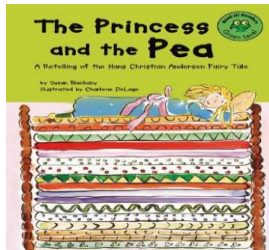
Admin Job Vacancy at St John's
