WELCOME BACK

May we take this opportunity, on behalf of all the governors and staff, to welcome yourselves and your children back to St. John's for the start of a new school year. This applies to everyone, but especially the new Nursery and Reception children who are joining us for the first time.

Again, we hope that we can do everything possible to make sure that your children enjoy the forthcoming months. We will endeavour to ensure that they are happy and that they make good progress.

However, these things do not happen by magic, and it is very much dependent on hard work from everyone involved. It is also important to remember that this is very much a partnership between home and school. Therefore, in order for continued success, **we need your support.**

It would be a great help if you could ensure that your child(ren):

- Were heard read regularly.
- Completed their homework on time.
- Arrived at school on time (9:05 in EYFS/KS1, 8:55 in KS2).
- Are collected on time at the end of the day (3:15 in EYFS/KS1, 3:30 KS2 (4:15 if in a club)).
- Didn't take holidays during term time (**see below**).
- Wore the correct uniform (**labelled with their name**) and proper, sensible shoes.
- Left school at the end of the day in a safe and orderly manner, that does not upset any of our neighbours.
- Displayed the good manners and sense of respect that would make you proud of them.
- Had their PE kits in school every week.

These simple little things really do help the school to run smoothly. Thank you.

NURSERY AND RECEPTION APPLICATIONS

Application forms for places in both the Nursery and Reception classes starting in September 2018 are now available from Mrs. Parkin in the infant site office. Once completed, either application must be returned to the school. However, applications for a place in the Reception class **must also be made online to Oldham Council**. CHILDREN STARTING SECONDARY SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2018

For those children currently in Year 6, a letter has been sent home (before we finished for summer) about applying for secondary school places for September 2018, when your child is due to start secondary school. You will need to complete an application using the online application system available on the Oldham Council website. This is the **ONLY** way that parents can make an application for a secondary school place. The online system opened on the **1st August 2017** and closes at **5:00pm on 31st October 2017**.

If you don't have access to the Internet, there are computers in all Oldham libraries. You will need an email address, but these are very easy to set up and staff in the library will be happy to help.

Children who are intending to attend a voluntary aided school may also be required to fill in a supplementary form or provide documentation in addition to the online application. These supplementary forms, for schools such as Blue Coat, are available from, and should be returned to, the respective school. However, please be aware of the admission criteria regarding such admissions, particularly in respect of church attendance, and make sure that you meet them.

KEY STAGE 2 SCHOOL MILK AND FRESH FRUIT

A letter, sent home earlier in the week, explained how we will continue to provide milk each morning to those who order it on a termly basis (£10.30). No other drinks are permitted in school apart from water (or fruit drinks which children may bring **only** as part of a packed lunch).

In addition to the sale of milk, fresh fruit is also sold on a daily basis. This usually includes those fruits that need no preparation, such as apples, bananas and pears etc. The cost will be 20p and can be bought on the day. The other alternative is that the children bring their own fresh fruit, but **not** fruit winders or fruit flakes etc. Many thanks for your understanding in this matter.

HOLIDAYS DURING TERM TIME

For over two years now, the school has issued the same advice regarding term time holidays. Following instructions from the government, we are no longer able to authorise any requests for such absences. Therefore, for that reason, please could we make a special request that you don't arrange holidays during term time. Apart from the potential fine, it is particularly disruptive, not only for the school, but also for your children. They will miss out on important lessons and this all needs catching up. It is also important to note, that you may be asked to account for unexplained absences, which means that going on holiday and not informing school is unacceptable. Therefore, please inform us if your child is going to be absent.

100% ATTENDANCE

Continuing on the subject of attendance, and in an effort to maintain good attendance, we will be awarding certificates and badges to those children who manage 100% attendance during this coming academic year. That means, they will be in school for both morning and afternoon registration, and will not have missed the close of the registers, which means they have not been late. As well as that, they have not been on holiday during term time.

This year, we also intend to make these awards on a termly basis, with a star badge being awarded each term for full attendance.

1 ★ for 100% attendance during the Autumn term (September to Christmas)

2 ★★ for 100% attendance during the Spring term (January to Easter)

3 ★★★ for 100% attendance during the Summer term (After Easter to Summer)

Any child who gains all 3 star badges will also achieve the 100% badge, which will be a great accomplishment.

CLASS SWIMMING LESSONS

Children in classes 2 and 3 will start their swimming lessons next week (Monday for class 2, Friday for class 3). Information and permission slips should have come home with the children yesterday, but if you have any questions, please contact school.

ASTHMA/ALLERGY/CONTACT DETAILS

To help us to make sure that your child is as safe as possible at school, we will be sending home forms for up-to-date contact details, allergy and other medical information over the next few days. Could you please ensure that these are filled in / amended and return to school so that we can update our records.

HOME/SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Next week, we will also be sending out a new home school agreement, along with letters allowing your children to go off-site and visit local sites that are within walking distance (e.g. the church, the high school etc.). These documents are vital for your children to achieve their best at school, and we ask that you take your time in reading them, and then return them to school.

CLASS INFORMATION

All children will be bringing home a class newsletter next week that will give information about what subjects are being taught in that class, and any other pertinent information for those children.
